Conclusion and Outlook



- Implementation of the CAI (Commonly Agreed Interface) is starting on site of the In-Time partner cities and TISP
- Test phase of In-Time is going to start in May 2010 and will last at least 1 year
- Positive impacts on environment and traffic safety are expected by changing travel behaviour of the single traveller and by lowering energy consumption in traffic through the use of In-Time
- Dissemination of results will attract follower cities and TISP across Europe
- In-Time will become a standardised multimodal real-time traveller information system within Europe
